- Witness the legacies of the 2010 Winter Olympic Games through site tours and presentations.
- Receive many useful resources daily that help bring Canada to your classroom.
- Return home with lesson plans and curriculum ideas that meet your classroom needs and national standards.

**Program Fee (REDUCED!): \$500** (includes tuition, lodging, breakfasts, and RT Vancouver-Whistler transportation)

**Registration Deadline: May 1, 2010** (NB: The full program fee is due with the registration application – 20 teachers are the maximum enrolled so registering early helps to avoid disappointment. Note that transportation to/from Vancouver, Canada, is not included but that Canada in the Classroom Awards can help recoup travel costs.\*

**Accommodations:** Deluxe accommodations with 2D/Q beds (assigned to 2 same-gendered participants).

**Supplemental Fees:** A \$400 supplemental fee is charged for a private room (50% of room cost). Companions can be registered at a supplemental cost of \$500 each and are welcome to attend events and activities. Entry fees are excluded. Any supplemental fees are also due with registration payment unless special arrangements are made.

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\*For 2010, WWU and UW are offering **Canada in the Classroom Awards** (\$100-\$400) to registrants who submit a one page (max) response that justifies how STUDY CANADA participation will improve their classroom curricula and benefit American K-12 students. Amounts awarded vary depending on distance traveled within the US so include an estimate of transportation costs to/from Vancouver, B.C. Apply to [tina.storer@wwu.edu](mailto:tina.storer@wwu.edu) before May 1. Awards will be announced on May 15 and distributed, in person, on June 20, 2010. If other scholarship opportunities become available, the news will be announced through the monthly resource notice to the Canada Listserv and posted online.



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
