

Three awards are currently available:

1) Canada in the Classroom Awards

WWU offers **Canada in the Classroom Awards** to registrants of the **2010 STUDY CANADA Summer Institute** who are not already receiving travel support from their school, district or employer.

To apply, please submit a one page (maximum) essay that describes **how STUDY CANADA participation will improve classroom curricula and benefit American K-12 students**. Applications for the award should be emailed directly to tina.storer@wwu.edu within a week of submitting registration applications to EESP. Awards will be announced by May 1 or earlier and distributed, in person, on June 20, 2010.

The amounts awarded range from \$100 to \$400 and consider the distance traveled within the US. It is useful to include an estimate of transportation costs to/from Vancouver, B.C. in the cover letter/email. See chart below.

2) New/Beginning Teacher Support

A \$300 award will be awarded to one (or divided among 2-3) student, pre-service or beginning teachers. Submission of a lesson plan created as an outcome of participation in the workshop is required by August 1, 2010. Awards will be announced by May 1 or earlier and sent by mail in August on receipt of the lesson plan.

3) Canada-America Society (CAS) K-12 STUDY CANADA Award

To be eligible for the single \$300 award, applicants must be a Washington State certified teacher. A one-year single membership to CAS (value \$40) is included. The recipient of the award must submit a report by July 1, 2010 to the Canada-America Society (care of tina.storer@wwu.edu) that describes the value of the STUDY CANADA workshop to your classroom/curriculum. The report (or excerpts) may be posted on CAS and/or K-12 STUDY CANADA websites.
